



Finnish Recovery Boiler Committee

Award for best master's thesis (30cr) in pulp mill chemical recovery area

Rules:

1. Reward is 2.000 €.
2. Prize will be awarded in Soodakattilapäivä-seminar which is held in October.
3. A nominee must have been awarded the Master's degree between dates September 1 previous calendar year and August 31 current calendar year.
4. The master's thesis must be related to the pulp mill's chemical recovery process.
5. Application and thesis should be submitted to Finnish Recovery Boiler Committee secretary by August 31.
6. Selection Committee, consisting of two Executive Board members which represent pulp industry and recovery boiler manufacturer and Committee secretary.
7. All applicants will be assessed on the basis of the following criteria:
 - a) *Significance of the study*
 - b) *Outcomes and accomplishments from the thesis*
 - c) *Originality*
8. Selection Committee will give recommendation to the Executive Board before the first autumn meeting.
9. The winner of the award is decided on the first Executive Board meeting. Executive board can choose the winner outside the Selection Committee recommendation. The Committee secretary will announce the winner of the award.
10. The Executive Board reserves the right not to award the prize, if the theses fail to meet the required standards.
11. The winner is invited to the Soodakattilapäivä-seminar to present their work.
